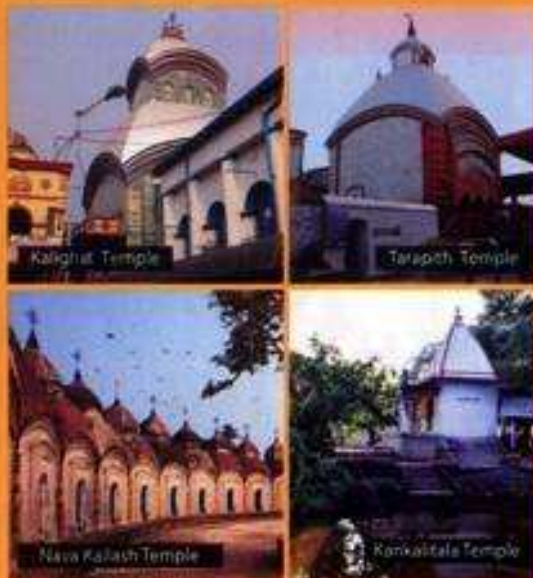


The Shakti Trail

The tour covers Dakshineswar, Kalighat, Chitreswari, Nava Kailash, Kankalitala, Bakreswar, Tarapith, Nalhati temples.

The Shakti Trail (3N 4D)

- Day 1 :** Departure Tourism Centre Kolkata. Visit Dakshineswar, Kalighat, Chitreswari Temple. Overnight at Udayachal T. L.
- Day 2 :** Transfer to Shantiniketan T. L. Enroute visit Attahas - Bahula. Night halt at Shantiniketan T. L.
- Day 3 :** Visit Kankalitala - Bakreswar-Tarapith-Nalhati. Overnight at Shantiniketan T. L.
- Day 4 :** Departure for Kolkata.

The Shiva Trail

Shiva is 'the destroyer', or in other words 'the transformer', among the Hindu Trinity as he dissolves in order to create. Worship of Shiva, in the form of Linga, is in wide practice all over the country.

Tour begins with Tarakeswar temple, built around a 'swayambhu' (self-manifested) linga in 1729 AD, popularly referred as Baba Taraknath. It passes through a complex of 108 Shiva temples at Kalna built by the King of Burdwan in 1809 AD, Ekteswar temple at Bankura, Malleswar temple at Bishnupur; Jorbangla and Shyamrai temples.

The Shiva Trail (3N 4D)

- Day 1 :** Departure Tourism Centre Kolkata. Visit Tarakeswar Temple. Overnight at Tarakeswar T. L.
- Day 2 :** Transfer to Shantiniketan T. L. Enroute visit Nava Kailash Temple. Night halt at Shantiniketan T. L.
- Day 3 :** Visit the out skirts of Bankura Town & overnight at Bishnupur T. L.
- Day 4 :** Departure for Kolkata.

The Chaitanya Trail intends to cover temples dedicated to Lord Krishna and also the places where Chaitanya's presence are prominent. The temples include Rasmancha, Pancha Ratna, Jor Bangla, Lalji, Radha Shyam, Madanmohan, Radha Govinda and Radha Madhab in Bankura, Chaitanya temple, Brindabanachandra, Ramchandra and Krishnachandra temples at Guptipara, Sonar Gourango temple and Chaitanya Saraswat Math in Nabadwip and ISKCON at Mayapur.

The Chaitanya Trail (3N 4D)

- Day 1 :** Departure Tourism Centre Kolkata. Visit terracotta temples in Bishnupur. Night halt at Bishnupur T. L.
- Day 2 :** Transfer to Guptipara & visit different temples. Overnight at Udayachal T. L.
- Day 3 :** Visit Nabadwip & Mayapur. Night halt at ISKCON Guest House Mayapur.
- Day 4 :** Departure for Kolkata.
